Leader: The Apostle Paul summarized the moral law of God by saying, Congregation: Put to death, therefore, whatever belongs to your earthly nature: sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desires and greed, which is idolatry. Because of these, the wrath of God is coming. But now you must rid yourselves of all such things as these: anger, rage, malice, slander, and filthy language from your lips. Do not lie to each other, since you have taken off your old self with its practices

Corporate Confession of sin:

We are guilty of forms of hypocrisy that we are still unaware of. You know us inside and out and you are fully aware of all those times we judge others and do the same things.

Lord we are sinners and have been from the beginning of our lives. Our only hope is in the sacrifice and genuine righteousness of your only begotten Son, the Lord Jesus Christ. In Him we find salvation; so in Him forgive us and renew us. So as we celebrate the incarnation of your blessed Son, turn us from hypocrisy to integrity. May we embrace and live the truth of Christ in all we do.

Confession of Faith: Formula of Chalcedon AD 451

We all with one accord acknowledge one and the same Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, at once complete in Godhead and complete in manhood, truly God and truly man, consisting also of a reasonable soul and body; of one substance with the Father as regards his Godhead, and at the same time of one substance with us as regards his manhood; like us in all respects, apart from sin; as regards his Godhead, begotten of the Father before the ages, but yet as regards his manhood begotten, for us men and for our salvation, of Mary the Virgin, one and the same Christ, Son, Lord, Onlybegotten, recognized in two natures, without confusion, without change, without division, without separation; the distinction of natures being in no way annulled by the union, but rather the characteristics of each nature being preserved and coming together to form one person and subsistence, not as parted or separated into two persons, but one and the same Son and Only-begotten God the Word, Lord Jesus Christ...
